The inaugural North East Florida Symposium on Underwater Archaeology will be held at the Guana Tolomato Matanzas National Estuarine Research Reserve, Ponte Vedra Beach just north of St. Augustine from March 20th through the 22nd, 2007. The Symposium, open to the general public, will cover a host of topics including pre-historic underwater archaeology, the archaeology of several shipwreck sites in Florida, agency jurisdictions of submerged cultural resources, international shipwreck projects, and graduate student archaeological research projects.
